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Art Techniques with Mr. Sam

Mondays: 6:00-7:00p at ILS Ballard

This class features a more personalized focus for students looking to expand their artistic skills. Mr. Sam will cover sketching, illustration, painting, and mixed media. Students will finish each week's lesson during class and can take their project home to finish if needed. 
Leighton Bareng, Lead Teacher at Ballard
